1. Theme and Topics

This symposium is a geometry symposium organized internationally. 17 th year of symposium will be held in 2019 at Erzincan/Turkey. So, this is a long-established organization. The symposium will consist of, in series of keynote lectures, contributed short talks, virtual and poster presentations. The presentations will be given in English. The main aim of this symposium is to promote, encourage, and bring together researchers by providing a forum for the academic exchange of ideas and recent research works in the field of Geometry. This symposium will consist of studies in the field of geometry from around the world. Moreover, presentations will be made on Differential Geometry, Algebraic Geometry, Kinematics and Descriptive geometry etc. Also, this symposium will be open to interdisciplinary studies. In other words, the studies that give the relations between geometry and other fields of mathematics will be presented in this symposium. In addition, the articles consulting for this international symposium will contain the geometric applications of the innovations in science and technology. So, the articles to be presented at this symposium will be suitable for this special issue we want to be printed in journal “Conference Proceedings of Science and Technology (CPOST)”.

2. Consolidation of Submissions

The full guide for submission of proceedings, formatting and authors responsibility please refer to Conference Proceedings of Science and Technology Author Guidelines. Publication of proceedings and access to the journal is free at this time, that is, there is no page fee and no subscription fee to access any of the papers published. However, the proceedings cannot be used for commercial purposes. Authors submitting to proceedings to Conference Proceedings of Science and Technology should disclose any potential conflicts of interest. Conflict of interest is defined as a situation that has the potential to undermine the impartiality of a person because of the possibility of a clash between the

person's self-interest and professional interest or public interest. Conflict of Interest can also be defined as a situation in which a party's responsibility to a second-party limits its ability to discharge its responsibility to a third-party. These may be financial, non-financial, professional or personal in nature.

3. Review of Papers

The authors/contributors are requested to submit their full and revised version of the articles. The submitted proceedings should not have been published previously, nor be under consideration for publication elsewhere. The submitted proceedings will undergo blind peer review process before the acceptance. All contributing authors from 17 th International Geometry Symposium that are of interest within this issue theme are invited to submit a proceeding accepted and presented during 17 th International Geometry Symposium. All submissions will be managed by the Guest Editors and fully refereed according to the high standards of Conference Proceedings of Science and Technology. Accepted proceedings will be published online directly after acceptance. The printed issue will be published upon accumulation of a sufficient number of accepted papers.
